They participated in "getting-to-know-you" icebreaker activities such as a scavenger hunt for things that helped us to get to know each other. Advisory teachers are beginning to meet 1:1 with students to conduct reading benchmark assessments with students to get to know them better as readers and develop next steps/goals.
