## **School Description**

Odyssey Academy of Virtual Learning is a 4K-12 charter school in the Ripon Area School District, which opened in the fall of 2019 with 97 students. Currently, we have an enrollment of around 275 students. Odyssey Academy is a tuition-free 4K-12 project-based, virtual charter public school supporting parents across the state who want to educate their children at home. Whether homeschool families or families on the go, Odyssey empowers parents to make educational decisions for their children. Odyssey provides a truly unique learning option for parents to consider between traditional online public schools and homeschool by providing financial resources, access to quality curriculum, and the support of licensed teachers.

Goal 2: Train teachers into best practices for delivery of blended learning and virtual instruction: Staff have participated in the following professional development which enhances best practices in blended and virtual learning: SLATE, Literacy Leaders Conference CESA, Teach Your Heart Out 2.0 Virtual Conference, CESA 6- Integrating Social-Emotional Skills Into Literacy Workshop, Reading and Writing Strategies for the Online and In-person Classroom with Jennifer Serravallo, ESGI TeachCon, Uplifting Education Professional Development, PBL (Project Based Learning) Works 101 Workshop, Wisconsin eSchool Network Curriculum Review Team, CESA 6- Jan Richardson Webinar Build Deeper Comprehension (Primary Focus), iReady training, Simply K12 webinars, Ditch Summit-Goal Met
- 3. **Goal 3: Train teachers into best practices for delivery of Project Based Learning instruction.** 100% of Odyssey staff will be trained in Project Based Learning as of July 2021.-Goal Met
- 4. **Goal 4: Communicate required assessments with the Governance Board and parents through the handbook.** This is communicated in the handbook, which is posted on the website, grade level student expectation documents, newsletters and parent meetings. -Goal Met
- 5. **Goal 5: Increase communication and timely communication from Odyssey Academy Staff:** Odyssey Academy now offers a yearly parent and student orientation, monthly newsletters, quarterly student assemblies, and an emphasis of a 24-hour, business day, response time. **Goal Met**
- 6. **Goal 6: Odyssey Academy will improve online engagement:** This year, Odyssey Academy partnered with Niche.com to help tell our story. We have increased online profile views 1556% (first click) and engagement by 476% (clicks after the profile view) as compared to the previous year. Word of mouth continues to be Odyssey's greatest advertiser. **Goal Met**
- 7. **Goal 7: Odyssey Academy will increase emotional support and peer-to-peer interaction:** Twice a month, Odyssey Academy offers live Odyssey Connect sessions, held by our School Counselor. She also instructs monthly SEL lessons for Elementary students, and provides one-on-one sessions for students and families as needed. Odyssey is continuing to develop plans to increase their number of Field Trip opportunities. **Goal Met**
- 8. **Goal 8: High School students will receive timely support:** Every core content area hosts one project support hour each week. Additionally, every Friday staff offer "Office Hours" to assist students with any continued academic needs that persist or may arise. These hours have helped improve upon the expectations that staff have for student projects, digging deeper into the skills of inquiry. During the start of every school year, and continuously throughout the school year, students are trained on how to appropriately utilize each of the following platforms to assist with their understanding of ALEKS Math, HeadRush, Wisconsin Virtual School (WVS), and Infinite Campus (IC). **Goal Met**
- 9. **Goal 9: Maintain a graduation rate equal to or higher than RASD:** 100% Graduation rate in 2023-2024. Looking to increase the number of individuals attending the in person RHS graduation from one student.-Goal Met
- 10. Goal 10: Maintain an attendance rate equal to or higher than RASD. Goal Met
- 11. **Goal 11: Increase the number of open enrolled students:** Odyssey Academy increased open enrollment from 88 students to 113 in 2023 / 2024. **Goal Met**
- 12. **Goal 12: Increase School-Wide Math and Literacy Scores:** In 2023/2024 there are 4% fewer students who are one grade level behind in Literacy as of the end of the year compared to the beginning of the year per the school's iReady data. In Math, there was a 5% increase in students who are at or above grade level compared to the beginning of the year. **Goal Met**
